1. Educators of Beauty President, Angie Clevenger, signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the U.S. Department of Education on April 14, 2020. The institution has used or intends to use no less than 50% of the funds received under Section 1800 (a) (1) of the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institutions Certification and Agreement for Emergency financial aid grants to students is \$47,495.00
3. The total amount of emergency financial aid grants distributed to students under Section 1800 (a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the date of this Fund Report is \$11,600
4. The estimate number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, and thus eligible to receive emergency financial aid grants under the CARES Act as of the date of this Fund Report is 29.
5. The total number of students who received an emergency financial aid grant under the CARES Act as of the date of this report is 29.

The methods by which the institution used to determine which students would receive emergency financial aid grants and how much they would receive under Section 1800 (a) (1) of the CARES Act are as follows. Educators of Beauty College of Cosmetology has considered the needs of COVID-19 impacted students in creating this policy. The Institution determined that all eligible students have suffered roughly similar needs
